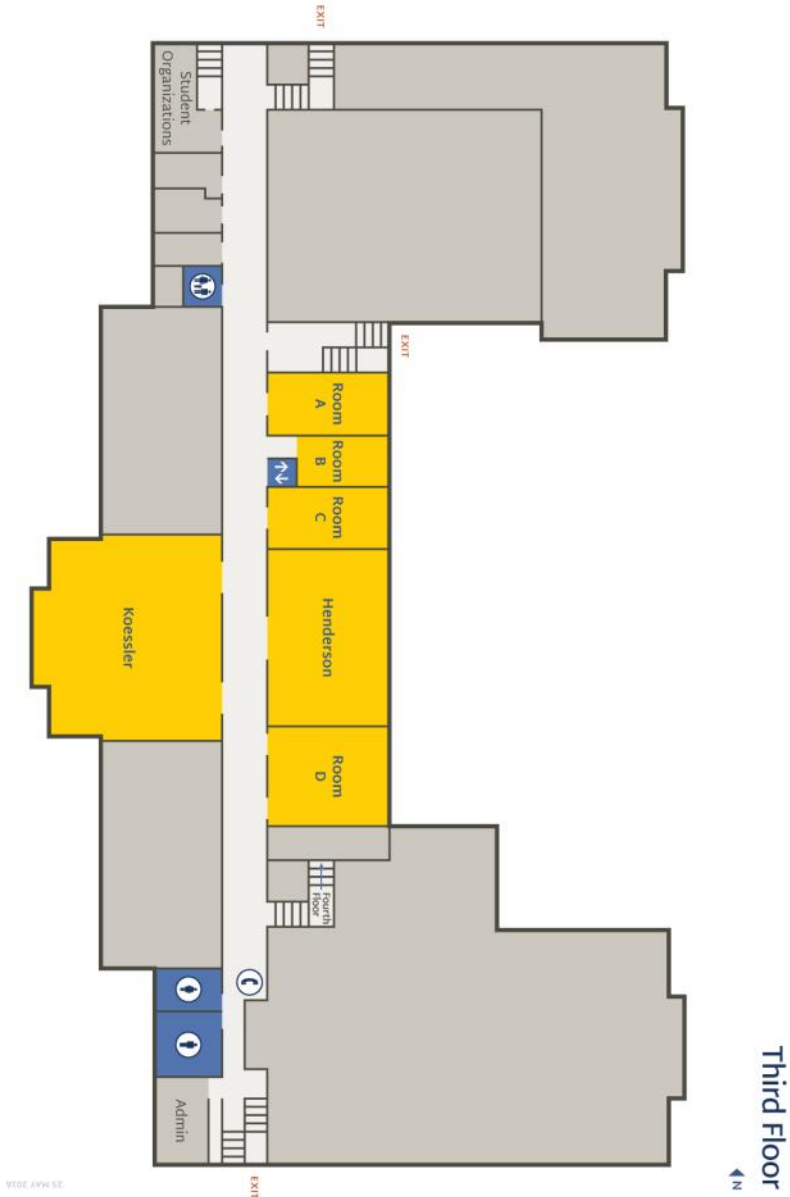
### **Campus Map**

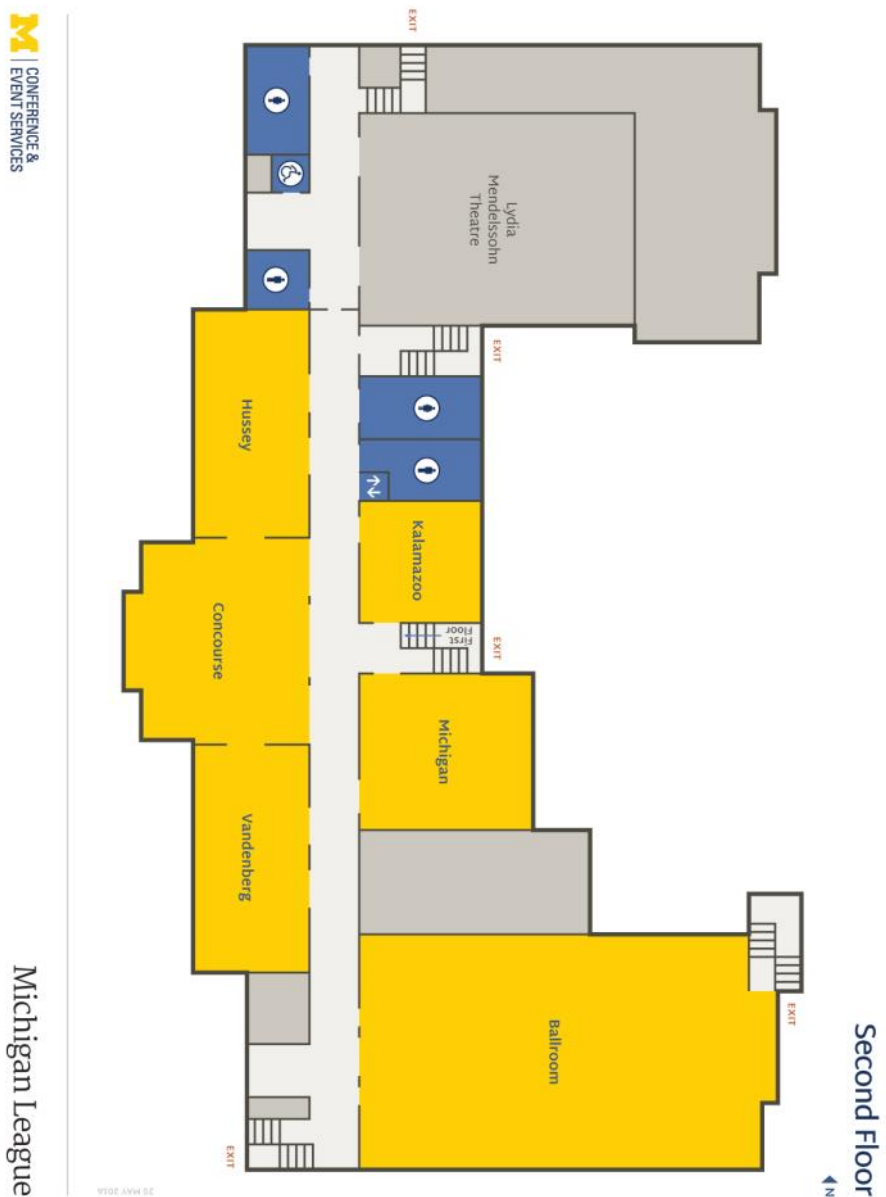

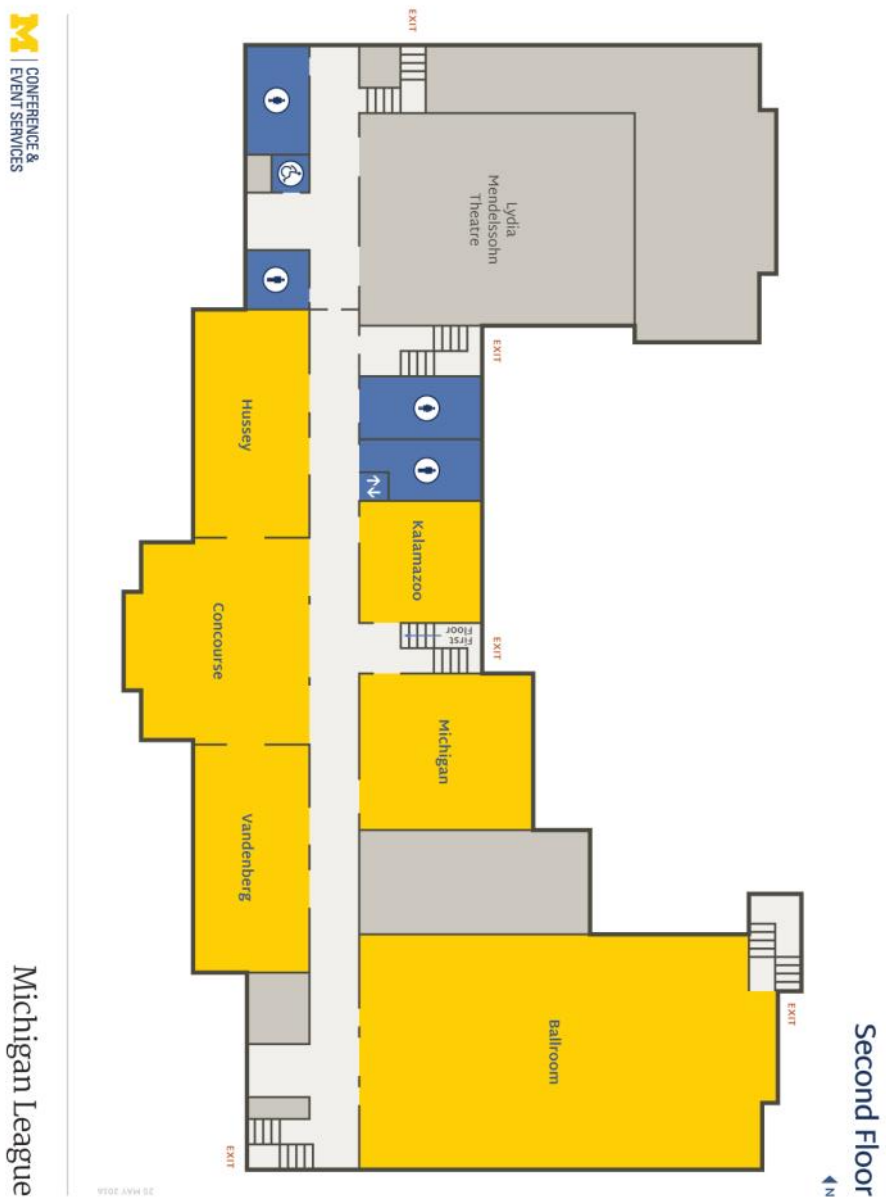

## Awards

### **Stuart A. Bremer Travel Award For the Best Graduate Student Paper**

The Stuart A. Bremer Travel Award is presented to the author(s) of the best graduate student paper delivered at each year's Peace Science Society meeting. Papers eligible for consideration include those associated with poster presentations made at the meeting as well as those presented at the meeting's regular sessions. Co-authored papers may be considered for the award if all of the authors are graduate students at the time of the meeting.

The author(s) of the winning paper receives travel support of \$2000 to present the paper at the 2025 meeting of the Network of European Peace Scientists in Barcelona, Spain. The winner will be selected on the basis of the paper's potential scientific significance and its contribution to the study of peace science. Nomination must be made by one of the authors of the paper.
